
What makes us special?



What Is Easter?


We will be talking the Easter story and how the palm cross symbolised Easter.

At home you could:


Create an Easter egg hunt to do together with family. Make an Easter card to end to someone you love.

In Early Years we LOVE sharing a story. For RE this term we will learn about two stories with important meaning behind them!




At home you could:
