| <b>Gymnastics</b> | Abbey Flyers at Meadowhead school – Trampolining club set up by Paul Greaves.<br>Sheffield Gymnastics academy in Sothall – behind Westfield school.   | Paul Greaves Trampolining and Gymnast coach attended Meadowhead School. He received the highest coaching award a coach can achieve from British Gymnastics. He coaches Bryony Page who achieved a silver medal in Rio. He's the only coach from Great Britain to have coached someone to an Olympic medal. |
| <b>Football</b>   | Sheffield had the first football club, Sheffield FC founded in 1857. Also have the second oldest club – Hallam FC formed in 1860. The first football 'derby' was played on Boxing day 1860 between Sheffield FC and Hallam FC.<br>Bramall Lane is the oldest major professional football ground, it is also one of two stadiums in the world that has hosted the FA Cup final and a cricket test match. | Derek Dooley, Gordon Banks – one of worlds most celebrated goal keepers and played in England's 1966 world cup team.<br>Nathaniel Creswick - co-founded Sheffield FC and established the Sheffield Rules.  |
| <b>Basketball</b> | Sheffield Basketball League started in 1950s. Sheffield Scorpions were the first knock out cup competition winners in 1965/66 season.   | Sheffield Sharks, The Arrows Basketball Club.  |
| <b>Athletics</b>  | Don Valley Stadium held athletics meetings since 1994.<br>Handsworth Roadhogs organised the Lord Mayor's 10k race, the first one being held in 1989.<br>Don Valley stadium has now been knocked down and an Olympic Legacy school has been built in its place.  | Jessica Ennis Hill, Sebastian Coe<br>Hallamshire Harriers, Handsworth Roadhogs, City of Sheffield Athletics Club, Rotherham Harriers   |
| <b>Tennis</b>     | Grove lawn tennis club founded in 1900 – Millhouses.<br><br>Hallamshire Tennis  | Freddrick Perry – Stockport who was the first (and only) British tennis player to win all four major open championships.<br>Hallamshire Tennis is home club of Jonathan Marray – 2012 mens' doubles Wimbledon Champion.  |
| <b>Hockey</b>     | Sheffield Hockey Club based at Abbeydale Park, is one of the oldest clubs in the country and the largest in South Yorkshire. First game recorded in 1898. | <b>Badminton</b> | Abbeydale Park Badminton Club – largest badminton club in Yorkshire   | Jack Shepherd – Paralympic athlete based at EIS. Head coach for para badminton Richard Morris attended Westfield School as a child.          |
| <b>Cricket</b>   | Sheffield Collegiate the Sheffield cricket club founded in 18 <sup>th</sup> Century was key in development of cricket in Northern England. Earliest match references 1751.  | Michael Vaughan, Joe Root both came from Sheffield Collegiate Cricket. Richard Kettleborough (umpire and ex England international cricketer) |
| <b>Handball</b>  | Sheffield Handball Club set up in 2007 by a group of University of Sheffield Students.  | Sheffield Handball club  |
| <b>Rugby</b>     | Rugby has been played in Sheffield since 1860's. Sheffield rugby Union FC was founded in 1902 and is based at Abbeydale Park. 4 Sheffield players represented Yorkshire in the first ever recorded county match against Lancashire in 1869. | Sheffield Tigers, Sheffield Rugby Union, Sheffield Eagles.<br>Jason Robinson OBE – Leeds   |
