
What makes us special?


Key vocabulary: Mummy, Daddy, brother, sister, Nannan, Grandad, family

At home you could:


Look at and talk about family photos together. Go and spend time with a family member you don't often see


Key vocabulary: Gift, thank you, Christmas, celebrate



At home you could: Let your child help choose a gift someone special at Christmas. Share a Christmas story together Practise using 'please' and 'thank you' in conversations

Key vocabulary: Birthday, celebrate, present, card, cake




At home you could:

At home you could:


Create an Easter egg hunt to do together with family. Follow a recipe and bake some hot cross buns. Get creative and make an Easter chick!

Key vocabulary: Hare, tortoise, fable- a story with a meaning


At home you could: Get creative and craft a tortoise! Have an egg and spoon race- is it better to go faster or slower?
